## Micro Switch vs. Carling (AEC S700 Series) Terminal Numbering for Two-Pole Switches


Getting the sides swapped doesn't make any difference for the tandem transfer switches like the -3, -5, -7. However, there is no industry convention for terminal numbering and when applied to the

progressive transfer devices like the -10, -50and -70, it is important to note differences between the two brands.

Drawings in the AeroElectric Connection and on our website have grown up with a mixed collection schematics for BOTH brands. This data sheet should enable you to sort out the appropriate switch terminal numbering for your application irrespective of the brand you are using.
